Tucked away in New England and the Canadian Maritimes is a motorcycling paradise. Travel with us through the superb mountains of Vermont, New Hampshire. Massachusetts and the Adirondacks or along the spectacular seacoasts of northern Maine, New Brunswick, Nova Scotia and the Gaspé Peninsula. Lean your bike along an alpine road that rises up into the clouds and leads you to the summit of Mount Washington. Follow the scenic sweeping curves of

a rushing river. Wind through the hairpin turns of mountain notches and gaps. Pause to enjoy the simple beauty of a classic New England village. Glide by pure blue lakes and inhale the rich scent of a pine forest. Feel the exhilaration of the Cabot trail, one of the world's greatest motorcycle roads, as it twists and turns along the edge of the Atlantic ocean and through the mountains, providing breathtaking views for more than 200 miles. Explore small villages, excellent historical sites, beautiful beaches, inland seas, traditional Gaelic music festivals and much more.

It's Up To You

Northeastern Motorcycle Tours offer luxury, companionship and freedom from most touring hassles without ever taking the fun or adventure out of touring. Each day of your tour will feature an organized group ride, or you can use our custom tour maps and directions to strike out on your own. Ride ahead, spend more time at your favorite places or explore other roads

and destinations. You can rejoin us further along the route, at the day's lunch stop or later at dinner.



Our tours typically last from four to nineteen days. The riding pace is relaxed with frequent stops to enjoy the area; we'll typically cover 170 - 200 miles per day. We'll also spend two or more nights per week in one location so that you have the option, if you choose, of taking time off the motorcycle to explore an area on foot or by using short local rides. All tours are limited to ten motorcycles and fifteen participants to keep group sizes small. Custom tours are available.







A Great Location

Our location in the southern Vermont town of Brattleboro puts us almost at the center of a triangle formed by the American cities of New York and Boston and the Canadian city of Montreal. We are 234 miles (377 kilometers) from Montreal, 194 miles (313 kilometers) from New York City and only 102 miles (165 kilometers) from Boston. Both interstate and scenic secondary roads connect us to each of these cities. Tour members often participate in our motorcycle tours after business visits or conferences in the northeast.

We also offer tours just before and after the famous and very popular "Americade" motorcycle rally, which is an

easy and beautiful half-day ride away in Lake George, New York. We can also arrange motorcycle rentals for the Americade event for riders on our tours.




Fly and Ride


Fly into New York, Boston or Montreal and be minutes away from your discounted motorcycle rental and a short ride away from the start of a spectacular tour. A wide range of motorcycles are available to choose from, including models from BMW, Harley-Davidson and Honda. Local rentals of Honda motorcycles can also be arranged near our tour base in Vermont.

Support Vehicle

Each Northeastern Motorcycle Tour is accompanied by a late-model air-conditioned support van, which carries extra luggage and up to three passengers. The support vehicle is in constant radio contact with the lead motorcycle and also carries a cellular telephone for emergency use. The van tows a Chariot trailer with fairing and is available to carry any disabled motorcycle should the need arise.







Luxurious Lodging

There's nothing quite like finishing a great day of riding and arriving at a luxurious inn or hotel to find your room waiting for you. Every *Northeastern Motorcycle Tour* includes exceptional accommodations ranging from classic New England inns to spectacular resorts to grand hotels on the Atlantic.
